The Grade Six Literacy Program focuses on an integrated approach to reading and writing, and is designed to give students a lot of practice of fine-tuning these critical academic skills. Throughout our in-class and independent reading, students will tackle many essential questions through our readings and discussions including:

-What is more revealing about an individual's character: actions or words?

-Is freedom or conformity more important in a just society? -What is justice and who decides?

-How can words capture a moment, idea, or observation, and how can I find the exact words to express myself?

WRITING, COMPOSITION AND LANGUAGE STUDIES

Grammar and mechanics will be taught as part of the writing curriculum, which is designed to give students a solid foundations for middle and high school writing expectations. Through all written assignments, students work towards mastery in the following categories: comprehension of topic, organization, idea development, language, and standard English conventions.

Our vocabulary program provides students with an introduction to Greek and Latin roots as they study prefixes, suffixes, and learning how to apply their knowledge of roots when trying to determine the meaning of an unfamiliar word.
