 When? Why? How?
- Your article must follow the inverted pyramid structure for news writing.
- Your article must have an interesting headline.
- Your article must have a few relevant "quotes" from relevant characters in the story. *These quotes can be made up.
- Your article must contain at least one picture with a caption. *Use
 Google Image search to find a picture that would fit within your article.
- Your article must be formatted using columns to resemble an actual newspaper article.

Procedure:

- 1. You will have one day/night to plan and draft your article.
- 2. You will have one class period in the computer lab to type your article.
- 3. You will have one night (homework) to edit and revise your article as needed.
